DEADLINE:

The completed form must be postmarked by April 30, 2006 to avoid \$100 late penalty.

NOMINATION FEES:

Note: For 2006 only, 3 and 4-year-old dressage horses may be nominated for the DRESSAGE PROGRAM ONLY for a one time fee of \$600. Horses nominated at this reduced fee may not switch to the jumper program.

- _____ Yearling: \$200 By a stallion nominated in 2004 when the foal was conceived (foaled in 2005)
- _____ 2-year-old: \$600 By a stallion nominated in 2003 when the foal was conceived (foaled in 2004)
- _____ 3-year-old: \$1000 By a stallion nominated in 2002 when the foal was conceived (foaled in 2003)
\$600 For Dressage horses ONLY for 2007. Not eligible for Jumper Futurity.
- _____ 4-year-olds: \$1400 By a stallion nominated in 2001 when the foal was conceived (foaled in 2002)

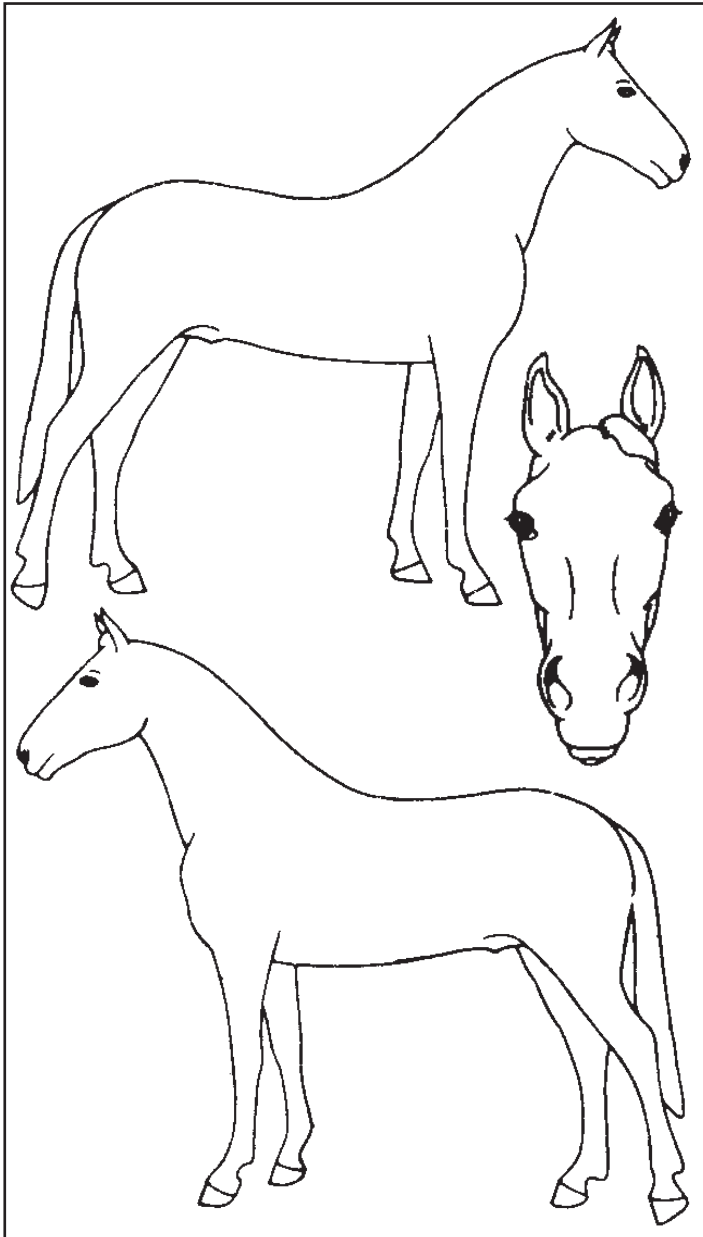

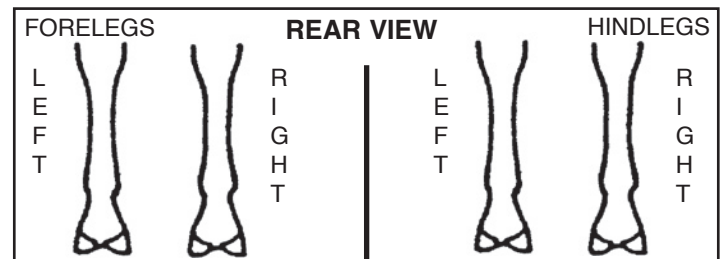
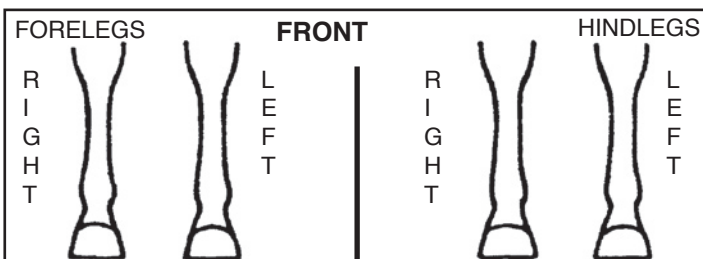

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

1. Eligibility for participation in the International Jumper/Dressage Futurity, (hereinafter IJF) program is contingent upon full payment of the required nomination fee. Eligibility shall be revoked if payments are not made by required deadlines.
2. The IJF reserves the right to cancel, postpone, or change the conditions of all or any part of the IJF without liability.
3. The IJF may desire to televise, broadcast, and/or record (on film or videotape) the IJF competitions and the activities incident to them, and to broadcast, exhibit and/or exploit same by any means now or hereafter known. All nominations are accepted only on the condition that the IJF reserves the rights to advertise the IJF in any manner it deems appropriate, including the use of names and likenesses of nominated stallions and their progeny. The nominator hereby expressly and irrevocably waives and releases any rights he may have in connection with any matter referred to in this paragraph including, without limitation, any claim to the invasion of the right or privacy or to misappropriation.
4. The nominator understands and agrees that any use by him of the name, logo, or material relating to the IJF will be restricted by the IJF.
5. The IJF reserves the right to utilize the funds received from nominations in such a manner as it deems appropriate, including, without limitations, the payment of administrative and promotional costs and expenses.
6. Stallion and Young Horse nomination fees are not refundable after the nomination deadline. The nomination fee is payable and accepted with the understanding that should the event be canceled a pro-rata share of the original fee paid shall be refunded, less promotional and administrative expenses, according to the nominator's share of the total fees paid.
7. Nominations and fees paid constitute an agreement between the nominator, the IJF, and any other associated party, that should any dispute arise, it shall be decided by the IJF and its committee, whose decision shall be final and binding to all parties.
8. Anyone who knowingly falsifies the nomination information may have his eligibility revoked and may be barred from competing in any or all IJF competitions.
9. The nominations and entries are accepted upon the condition that every entry in the IJF shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it, along with the owner, trainer, manager, agent, and rider, shall:
 - a) be subject to the rules of the IJF and the local rules of the event;
 - b) that every horse or rider is eligible as entered;
 - c) that the owner and his representatives are bound by the rules of the IJF and the event, and will accept as final the decision of the IJF Executive Committee on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, the IJF, and its officials, directors, and employees harmless for any action taken;
 - d) that the owner, rider, and any of their representatives agree to hold the IJF, the show, officials, directors, employees, and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the IJF, whether or not such injury or loss results, directly or indirectly, from negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees, or agents of the IJF or the show. The construction or application of these rules are governed by the laws of the State of California.

The International Jumper Futurity is a 501(c)5 non-profit, non-stock corporation organized under the laws of the State of California.



2006 International Jumper Futurity Program Guidelines

Competitions

Three competitions will be held each year. Every IJF nominated 4 year old horse is eligible for entry in one competition. Each event will be held in conjunction with a major jumper show. Every effort will be made to schedule the IJF competitions to assure the greatest possible exposure for these horses. Every IJF nominated horse will also be eligible to compete in all Young Jumper Championship competitions with no additional nomination fees required.

Competition Entries and Drug Testing

IJF entry forms will be mailed to all 4 year old owners approximately 2 months prior to the competitions. All entrants must contact the horse show hosting the IJF event for stabling and drug forms prior to the show's closing dates. The IJF may conduct drug testing for forbidden substances in conjunction with, or in accordance to USEF testing.

Four Year Old Program-open only to IJF Nominated 4 year olds.

- To be eligible to compete, 4 year olds must never have entered or competed in any jumper event with fences exceeding 3'9" in height.
- A horse's participation in hunter events will not effect his/her eligibility.
- Prize money awarded to winners in the IJF events will not effect the horse's preliminary status with USEF. Prize money is generated through the nomination fees from stallions and young horses. Each horse entered in this year's competition who completes both rounds will receive \$1000. Trophies and additional prize money will be given for three categories. Breeders awards of \$200 will be given to each stallion nominator. The original young horse nominators will receive \$100.
- Participating in the IJF events will not, in itself, jeopardize a horse's First Year Green eligibility for the following year.

IJF Bonus Awards and YJC 5, 6 and 7/8 Year-Old Programs

All nominated IJF horses are encouraged to enter Young Jumper Championship (YJC) competitions. Additional IJF Bonus Prize money will be paid to the top six IJF horses in each final YJC competition. \$10,000 per class (a total of \$60,000) is available ONLY to IJF nominated horses that place in the top 15 at the YJC Eastern and Western League Finals.

NOMINATION FEES:

Note that for 2006 only, 3 and 4-year-old dressage horses may be nominated for the DRESSAGE FUTURITY ONLY for a reduced fee of \$600. (See Dressage Futurity Guidelines)

Horses nominated for the reduced fee may not compete in the jumper portion of the futurity or earn bonuses through the Young Jumper Championships. Dressage horses nominated for the full fee as detailed below may compete in either portion of the Futurity. Horses that were previously nominated to the International Jumper Futurity MAY compete in the dressage portion at no additional fee but may not do both disciplines in the same year.

THREE-YEAR-OLDS	By a stallion nominated in 2002, when the foal was conceived. Foaled in 2003. FOR 2007 4YO DRESSAGE NOMINATIONS ONLY - \$600 Nomination Fee. FOR 2007 4YO DRESSAGE or JUMPERS- \$1000 Nomination Fee.
FOUR-YEAR-OLDS	By a stallion nominated in 2001, when the foal was conceived. Foaled in 2002. FOR 2006 4YO DRESSAGE NOMINATIONS ONLY - \$600 Nomination Fee. FOR 2006 4YO DRESSAGE or JUMPERS- \$1400 Nomination Fee.
FIVE & SIX-YEAR-OLDS	By a stallion nominated in 1999-2000, when the foal was conceived. Foaled in 2000 OR 2001. \$2,000 Nomination Fee. Horse is eligible for Dressage or Jumper Program.
BREEDER DISCOUNTS	Nominate two get third one FREE! There is no limit to the number of nominations under this schedule. All horses must be the same age and owned by the same nominator. Contact the IJF office (ijfoffice@youngjumpers.com) for more information. Nominate two get third one FREE.
LATE FEE	Nominations postmarked after April 30, 2006 Late Fee \$100.
NAME OR OWNER CHANGE	Change of name, or Transfer of Ownership. Name Change or Ownership Transfer Fee \$50.

2006 International Dressage Futurity Program Guidelines

Competitions

The International Dressage Futurity will be based on the average of the BEST TWO SCORES cores earned in the FEI 4-year-old test at USDF/USEF recognized dressage competitions. Every IJF and IDF nominated 4 year old horse is eligible for entry. Check the website for a calendar of recognized competitions after November 1: www.breeders-futurity.com

Four Year Old Dressage Program-open only to IJF and IDF Nominated 4 year olds.

- A horse's participation in other dressage events will not effect his/her eligibility.
- Prize money is generated through the nomination fees from stallions and young horses. Each horse entered in this year's competition will receive prize money based on their score: \$750 for 6.5 to 7.5; \$1,000 for 7.6 to 8.4; and \$1,500 for 8.5 or above. In addition, \$100 will be paid to the original nominator of the horse and \$200 to the stallion nominator for every offspring by the stallion completing the test with a qualifying score of 6.5 or above. Trophies and additional prize money will be given for three categories.

IDF Bonus Awards and 5 and 6-Year-Old Programs

All nominated IDF horses are encouraged to enter Young Jumper Championship or Young Dressage Horse Championship competitions. Additional IDF Bonus Prize money will be paid to the top six IDF horses in the Young Dressage Horse Championships.

NOMINATION FEES: Note that for 2006 only, 3 and 4-year-old dressage horses may be nominated for the DRESSAGE FUTURITY ONLY for a reduced fee of \$600.

Horses nominated for the reduced fee may not compete in the jumper portion of the futurity or earn bonuses through the Young Jumper Championships. Dressage horses nominated for the full fee as detailed below may compete in either portion of the Futurity. Horses that were previously nominated to the International Jumper Futurity MAY compete in the dressage portion at no additional fee but may not do both disciplines in the same year.

FOUR-YEAR-OLDS	By a stallion nominated in 2001, when the foal was conceived. Foaled in 2002. FOR 2006 4YO DRESSAGE NOMINATIONS ONLY - \$600 Nomination Fee. FOR 2006 4YO DRESSAGE or JUMPERS- \$1400 Nomination Fee.
FIVE & SIX-YEAR-OLDS	By a stallion nominated in 1999-2000, when the foal was conceived. Foaled in 2000 OR 2001. \$2,000 Nomination Fee. Horse is eligible for Dressage or Jumper Program.
BREEDER DISCOUNTS	Nominate two get third one FREE! There is no limit to the number of nominations under this schedule. All horses must be the same age and owned by the same nominator. Contact the IJF office (ijfoffice@youngjumpers.com) for more information. Nominate two get third one FREE.
LATE FEE	Nominations postmarked after April 30, 2006 Late Fee \$100.
