## PEDIGREE

- HIS SIRE Liostro is the last approved son of Ladykiller. Ladykiller had the greatest impact on the Holsteiner breed according to Dr. Dietrich Rossow. He is considered to be one of the most important jumper sires of modern times.
- HIS DAM descends from Calypso II, whose progeny exhibit great jumping form and wonderful rideability. He produced a number of international performers - Chin Chin, Cheyenne, Calyno to name a few. His 18 stallion sons include Contender, Coriolan, Colani, Crazy Classic and Chasseur I and II. Calypso II is a son of Cor de la Bryere who is considered to be the stallion that revolutionized show jumping breeding. Cor de la Bryere produced progeny with great form over jumps. He was not only considered a great sire himself, but he sired many legendary sires - Caletto I, II and III, Calypso (I - V) and the Corrado stallions (I - III). Corrado has been a successful competitor under Franke Sloothaak. At his death, Cor de la Bryere had sired 85 approved sons and 65 States Premium daughters. On his dam's side, LioCalyon's great-great-grand sire is Sacramento Song, which stood for 7 seasons in Holstein. He sired Societe (D

## PERFORMANCE

LioCalyon retired in 2006 after a long and prolific career. He didn't miss a show season in almost 10 years of competition. In 2000, he won the Bakersfield GP and Menlo Charity GP and in 2002, the Bakersfield GP and Country Classic GP. He won numerous speed classes at Spruce Meadows and in the US., earning over \$100,000.

## PROGENY

Lio's offspring have entered the show arena with a bang. Peterbilt (2000 stallion), won the IJF West Coast 4 year old Futurity in 2004 and in 2006 was 2nd in the YJC West Coast 6-year old Championships. Provence (2001 filly) placed 4th in the YJC West Coast 5 Year Old Championships and Palancar (2000 mare) competed in the 6 year old finals exhibiting Lio's love of jumping and big heart. In New Zealand, Lio has young jumpers competing successfully in the YJCs. Cuff Link placed 2nd in the North Island 5 year old Champs., and Art Master was 3rd. Art Master is 2nd in the overall standings in the NZ YJCs.
